To formalize this commitment, TCI has renewed its Corporate Environmental Policy that applies to all aspects of the company.

This policy affirms how TCI will do its part to enhance environmental performance by:

- Complying with all applicable legislation, regulations and other requirements;
- Reviewing environmental objectives and targets annually, and setting targets that are challenging, yet realistic;
- Continually improving our environmental management system;
- Ensuring that all full-time, part-time, contract and temporary associates, suppliers and contractors are aware of their individual responsibilities for acting in accordance with the Environmental Policy;
- Providing effective information and training to improve individual awareness and encourage individual environmental responsibility; and,
- Encouraging associates to pursue activities that support TCI's environmental pillars of:

Pillar 1: Environmental Protection and harmony with nature

Pillar 2: Creation of a low-carbon society (e.g. greenhouse gas reduction)

Pillar 3: Recycling and Resource Preservation

Also included in the policy are the following specific directives for minimizing TCI's environmental impact by:


- Reducing waste material sent to landfill
